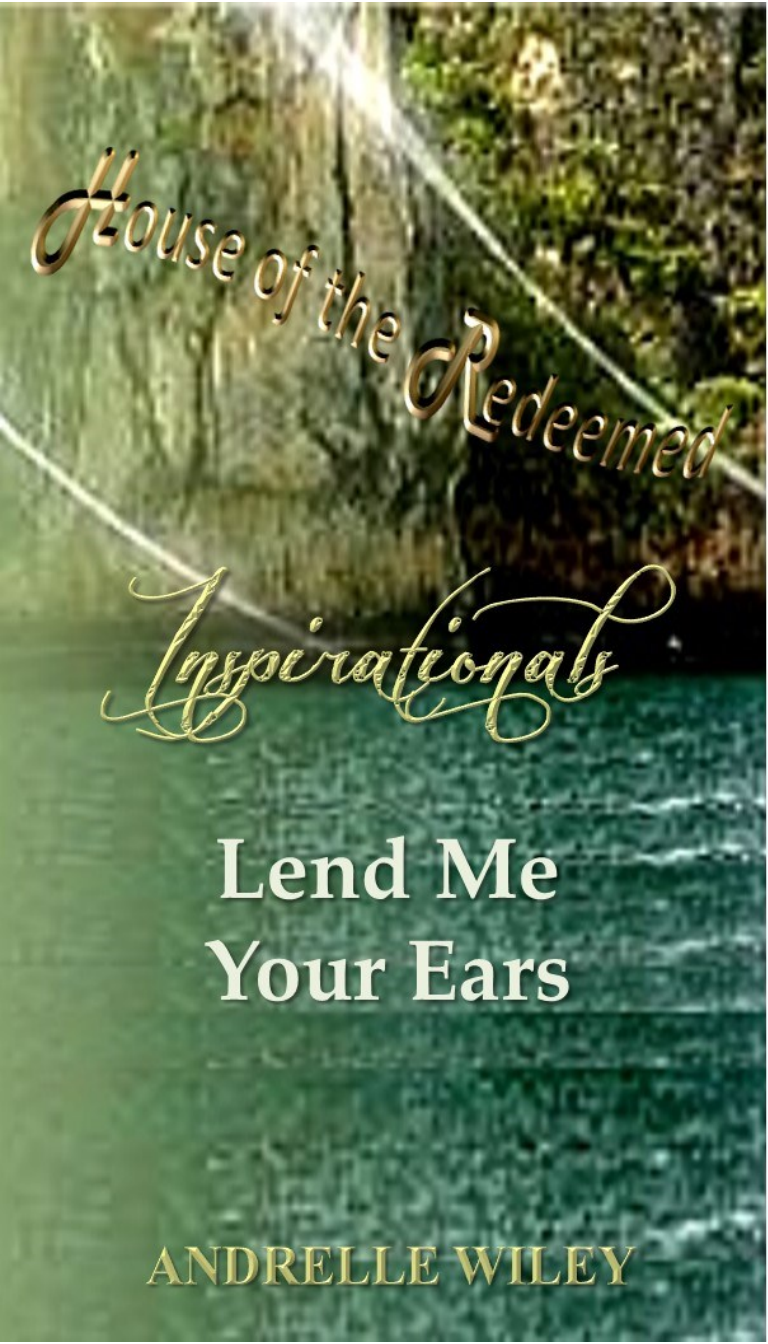

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PREFACE

**“Friends, Romans, countrymen, lend me
your ears; the evil that men do lives after
them;”**

-William Shakespeare

*L*ong after Hitler's death, we are still hearing today about that evil he did by executing six million European Jews and millions of other non-Aryans between 1933-1945; known as The Holocaust.

This confirms Shakespeare's statement. But it was not meant to be. Because in the beginning Moses was sent to Pharoah whose heart the Lord had hardened so that he mayest tell in the ears of thy son, and of thy son's sons, what things I [the Lord] have wrought in Egypt, and my signs which I have done among them; that ye may know how that I AM the LORD. Exodus 10:1-2.

What we choose to listen to today affects not only our Soul, but also our children's children's.

Because oftentimes what you hear, you speak, and children repeat, which has an effect: Death or Life. Furthermore, what you hear influences your actions and those actions can determine eternal life, or eternal damnation.

Everything God created has ears. How else could the sea know how far to wash ashore, or the tress know to shed their leaves in the Fall, or flowers bloom in the Spring, and how could the rocks cry out in praise? **Luke 19:40** And he answered and said unto them, I tell you that, if these should hold their peace, the stones would immediately cry out.

Trees

He replied, "If you have faith as small as a mustard seed, you can say to this [mulberry] sycamine tree, 'Be uprooted and planted in the sea,' and it will obey. **Luke 17:6**

Rocks

Take the rod, and
gather thou the
assembly together,
thou, and Aaron thy
brother, and speak ye
unto the rock before
their eyes; and it shall
give forth his water,
and thou shalt bring
forth to them water
out of the rock: so
thou shalt give the
congregation and
their beasts drink.

Numbers 20:8

Moses spoke to the rock and it gave forth water. The rock had to have ears in order to hear and obey.

Rivers

That saith to the
deep, Be dry, and I
will dry up thy
rivers: **Isa 44:27**

Sea

Do you not fear Me?' declares the LORD.
'Do you not tremble in My presence? For I have placed the sand as a boundary for the sea, an eternal decree, so it cannot cross over it. Though the waves toss, yet they cannot prevail; though they roar, yet they cannot cross over it. **Jeremiah 5:22**

Now let's turn our attention to another God creation.

Humans/Homosapiens, who are biologically classified in the Animalia (Animal) Kingdom.

If you ever observed animal behavior, you will see their ears are instinctive. A Deer for example can be nibbling on a leaf, but at the slightest sound of rustling signifying potential danger, it **runs from** the scene.

But let most humans hear a commotion outside of their environment, and they are the first to **run to** the scene.

Don't believe me? Think back to grade school. What was the first thing you did when a fight broke out? **Run To** [it to see].

If there is an accident, outside the home, or if an emergency response vehicle is heard on the street, folk have been known to leave their homes with curlers in their hair wearing nothing but nightgowns **running to** see.

And they are the ones usually on the news camera telling others “I seen it.” not I saw it.

So from our previous examples of nature, it seems to me every other creation with ears to hear, function by design and obey the Creator- except humans: whose Feet are swift to run to mischief. One of six abominations to the Lord listed in **Proverbs 6:18**

**Human mankind to whom have you
given your ears to obey?**

When Jesus walked throughout the earth he repetitiously stated those had ears to hear but did not. He was not referring to the physically deaf, but the spiritually deadened ears on human mankind.

Jesus said in **Matthew 13:13**, and **Mark 8:17-20** This is why I speak to them in parables: "Though seeing, they do not see; though hearing, they do not hear or understand. And when Jesus knew *it*, he saith unto them, Why reason ye, because ye have no bread? Perceive ye not yet, neither understand? Have ye your heart yet hardened? Having eyes do you not see, and having ears do you not hear? And do you not remember? When I brake the five loaves among five thousand, how many baskets full of fragments took ye up? They say unto him, Twelve.

Our ears were designed to obey the voice of the Lord & be in tune to the spiritual things of God. But because of pollution, the infiltration from the things associated with the spirit of the world, (**1 Corinthians 2:12**, which is controlled by the Prince of this World

John 14:30) many have ears to hear, but do not hear. Yet, if I were ask someone what they heard about Beyoncé, or what did “So and So” say on the chitlin’ circuit switch, the recounts would be rattled off almost word for word without hesitation.

But ask what Jesus specifically said to do in times of trouble.. The response may be, “umm, well, er ah..tee-hee. You know the Lord knows my heart.” Yea. It is deceitful and desperately wicked. **Jeremiah 17:9**

The answer, by the way, is found in **John 14:1-3**

Jesus said in **John 14:26** But the Comforter, *which is* the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you.

The body was designed to be in complete working Order.

So if we, man, were created after our (God and Jesus) image and likeness; Jesus' body did not have defects.

Therefore, the body of Christ, must ensure not one part of our bodies are out of order. Otherwise, there is imbalance.

Jesus spoke and the people listened. His words are written in red in the Bible. My sheep know my voice. Hear my voice. And they obey. He says **in John 10:27**

Therefore, be not conformed to this world, but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, reads **Romans 12:2**. Well, how can one's mind be

renewed if what they are listening to opposes the Spiritual Creator Jehovah?

Would you be without shame if Jesus listened to, or watched whatever you do inside your homes, or cars?

Well He is. And sometime He will comment.

I remember I was watching a video of a church play I was in. When it got to the part of a dance routine by an obvious homosexual. I audibly heard the Lord say, "I cannot watch that." I got up and immediately turned off the television, then destroyed the video.

Another time I was listening to a song classified as Gospel music, on the car radio. I cannot remember which but either the repetitious lyrics, or the chords themselves pricked my spirit

and I changed the station. As soon as I did, I audibly heard the Holy Spirit say, “Mausoleum Music.”

Another instance occurred when I visited a church in the Durham area, when the praise singers started singing, the noise pierced my ears like clanging cymbals and sounding brass to the point, I felt nauseous and had to leave.

There is a spirit behind everything you watch, or listen to. Satan is also a spirit. He was the Minister of Music in heaven who sang with the Morning stars. **Job 38:7**. This is why it is written in **1 John 4:1-5**, Beloved, believe not every spirit, but try the spirit by the [Holy] Spirit to see whether they are from God.

Not every song, or artist classified as “Gospel” is [music] for our ears.

It is written in Psalm chapters 96, and 98 verse 1, and Isaiah 42:10, Sing unto the Lord a new song; not remake a worldly song with so called gospel lyrics.

- Kirk Franklin's Whatcha Lookin For is a remake of Patrice Rushen's Haven't you heard.
- The Clark Sisters I Like Living This Kind of Life is a rendition of Funkin for Jamaica.

Likewise every preacher in the pulpit is not called, or teach from the Bible.

One phrase from the pulpit that has passed from generation to generation is: "The Lord won't put more on you than you can bear." Where is that written in the Bible?

Nowhere. The scripture written in 1 Corinthians 10:13 has been twisted for generations.

There hath no temptation taken you such as is common to man; but God is faithful, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that you are able; but

will with the temptation also make a way of escape, that you may be able to bear it. Wherefore, flee from idolatry.

Twisted Truth is Wickedness

Study to show thyself approved.

2 Timothy 2:15



For the time will come when they [human mankind] will not endure sound doctrine; but after their own lusts shall they draw to themselves teachers, having itching ears; And they shall turn away *their* ears from the truth, and shall be turned unto fables. But watch thou in all things, endure afflictions, do the work of an evangelist, make full proof of thy ministry. But you who are Christ's disciples, Preach the word; be instant in season, out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort with all longsuffering and doctrine. **2 Timothy 4:3**

Well since there is nothing new under the sun (Solomon writes in **Ecc1 1:9-10**)], that time of an itching hear was exemplified by Ahab written in **I Kings 22:1-8**, And it came to pass in the third year that Jehoshaphat the king of Judah came down to the king of Israel. And Jehoshaphat said unto the king of Israel, Enquire, I pray thee, at the word of the LORD to day. Then the king of Israel gathered the prophets together, about four hundred men, and said unto them, Shall I go against Ramothgilead to battle, or shall I forbear? And they said, Go up; for the LORD shall deliver it into the hand of the king. And Jehoshaphat said, "Is there not here a prophet of the LORD besides [these], that we might enquire of him?" And the king of Israel said unto Jehoshaphat, There is yet one man, Micaiah the son of Imlah, by whom we may enquire of the LORD: but I hate him; for he doth not prophesy

good concerning me, but evil. And Jehoshaphat said, Let not the king say so. And the messenger that was gone to call Micaiah spake unto him, saying, Behold now, the words of the prophets declare good unto the king with one mouth: let thy word, I pray thee, be like the word of one of them, and speak that which is good. And Micaiah said, As the LORD liveth, what the LORD saith unto me, that will I speak.

They wanted to hear False Prophets.

Whom neither the LORD spoke to, sent, or commanded them to say Thus saith the Lord.

Then the Lord said unto Jeremiah in chapter 14:4. The prophets prophesy lies in my name: I sent them not, neither have I commanded them, neither spake unto them: they prophesy unto a false vision and divination, and a thing of nought, and the deceit of their heart.

Be ye not as your fathers, unto whom the former prophets have cried, saying,

Thus saith the Lord of hosts: Turn ye now from your evil ways and from your evil doings: but they did not hear, nor hearken unto me, saith the Lord.

Zechariah 1:4

Rebellion is as the sin of witchcraft.

1 Samuel 15:23

Rebellion hardens the heart, causes spiritual hearing loss and spiritual blindness.

For this people's heart is waxed gross, and *their* ears are dull of hearing, and their eyes they have closed; lest at any time they should see with *their* eyes, and hear with *their* ears, and should understand with *their* heart, and should be converted, and I should heal them. **Matthew 13:15**

Ye stiffnecked and uncircumcised in heart and ears, ye do always

resist the Holy Ghost: as your fathers *did*, so *do* ye. **Acts 7:51**

To whom shall I speak, and give warning, that they may hear? Behold, their ear *is* uncircumcised, and they cannot hearken: behold, the word of the LORD is unto them a reproach; they have no delight in it. **Jeremiah 6:10**

He that turneth away his ear from hearing the law, even his prayer shall be abomination. **Proverbs 28:9**

For the eyes of the Lord are over the righteous and his ears are open unto their prayers: but the face of the LORD is against them that do evil. **1 Peter 3:12**

Your iniquities [in your heart] have separated you and God, and your sins have hid his face from you that He will not hear. **Isaiah 59:2, Psalm 66:18**

Now we know that God does not hear sinners; but if any man be a worshipper of God, and doeth his will, him he hears.
John 9:31

A sinner is defined as:

1. One that has voluntarily violated the divine law; a moral agent who has voluntarily disobeyed any divine precept, or neglected any known duty.
2. It is used in contradistinction to saint, to denote an unregenerate person; one who has not received the pardon of his sins.
3. An offender; a criminal.

In a prior topic we saw the word Reprobate.

A reprobate is when a sinner is so hardened as to feel no remorse or misgiving of conscience; Abandoned in sin; lost to virtue or grace.

They profess that they know God, but in works deny him, being abominable and disobedient, and to every good work reprobate. **Titus 1:16**

Reprobate silver shall men call them, because the Lord hath rejected them. **Jeremiah 6:30**

Reprobates are rejected by God

Wicked is defined as Departure from the rules of the divine law; evil disposition or practices; immorality; crime; sin; sinfulness; corrupt manners.

The wicked are estranged from the womb: they go astray as soon as they be born, speaking lies. Their poison *is* like the poison of a serpent: *they are* like the deaf adder *that* stoppeth her ear; God is not in all their thoughts. Their hearts are far from God. **Psalms 58:3-4,**

Psalm 10:4, Isaiah 29:13, and Matthew 15:8.

In order for God to hear us, and we hear from God, we must be in Relationship with him. And how do you cultivate a relationship with someone? You spend time with them. (*not just on your terms*)

But first we must Repent, which is defined as Sorrow for anything done or said; the pain or grief which a person experiences in consequence of the injury or inconvenience produced by his own conduct.

In theology, the pain, regret or affliction which a person feels on account of his past conduct, because it exposes him to punishment. This sorrow proceeding merely from the fear of punishment, is called legal repentance, as being excited by the terrors of legal penalties, and it may exist without an amendment of life.

Real penitence; sorrow or deep contrition for sin, as an offense and dishonor to God, a violation of his holy law, and the basest ingratitude towards a Being of infinite benevolence. This is called evangelical repentance, and is accompanied and followed by amendment of life.

**Repentance is a renewed mind
(turning your back on sin).**

For All have sinned and come short of the glory of God. **Romans 3:23**

There is joy in the presence of the Angels of God over one sinner that repents. **Luke 15:12**

After you repent and turn away from anything that displeases God begin to spend time with Him. He may send his angels to awaken you at what you may consider to be an Ungodly hour....

My hour was at 3:33am which correlate to **Jeremiah 33:3**. Call to Me and I will

answer you, and I will tell you great and mighty things, which you do not know.'

Learning to Hear the Holy Spirit

Most folk will say.. "Something told me.." Then normally do whatever they were told.

Well scripture says, In all thy ways acknowledge Him. **Proverbs 3:6.**

Just as you want to receive acknowledgment for doing a task, so does the Holy Spirit/Lord.

That "Something" has a name. The Holy Spirit.

Seek ye first the Kingdom of God and his righteousness **Matthew 6:33**

He Knows what you have need of before you A S K. **Matthew 6:8**

Not think you already know by leaning on your own (previous) understanding and know-how. That is Self-Righteousness

It is written in **Proverbs chapters 16:25** and **14:13**, there is a way that seemeth right unto man. But its end is the way of death. Woe to those who are wise in their own eyes, and shrewd in their own sight!
“Woe to him who strives with him who formed him; His Maker.

A S K the Holy Spirit Who, What, When, Where, and How.

Be Specific. Otherwise, you will get the answer to what you ask.

To know How to treat the Holy Spirit, you may want to refer to the Inspirational teachings, **The Comforter and the Holy Spirit and the Gifts He bear.**

Always Thank Him!

Hearing the Spiritual Realm

From my experience there are two ways to hear Jesus and the Holy Spirit:

1. Within yourself: Inner thoughts
2. Outside yourself: Audibly as if another person is speaking to you. You should be able to discern the direction from which the voice is speaking. God's voice is usually heard Outside yourself. There will be no mistaken when He speaks. The reverberation will rattle your inner core.

Jesus mostly speaks His Words written in scriptures.

Angels, ministering spirits, **Hebrews 1:14**, always speak Outside yourself

The Holy Spirit speaks correction, instruction, counsels, etc. parlaying the seven Spirits of God found in **Isa 11:2**. He knows you better than you think you know yourself. I call him my second skin. Scripture reads there is friend that sticketh closer than a brother. **Proverbs 18:24(b)**

Personal Examples of Hearing the Spiritual Realm

The other day I was in need of a (cheaply priced) Money Order. I asked where to go. While rambling through my futile thoughts of places to go. I was audibly told "Go to Kroger. They have Money Orders."

I was also in need of juice. Well there you go. Efficiency. I obeyed instruction.

My angels assisted me at home with assembling a chair. After my struggles, frustration, and nearly 'bout ready to ship it back cause I surmised it was defective. I heard an Angel say, "You might want to turn it around." Voila! I now have a fully functioning chair.

Daily, I ask what to wear. You never know what the day may hold, or where you may need to go.

Besides, if we are children of God then we should represent the Kingdom, and

look like a King's kid. Although you may not know it, we are always being watched. And sometimes our picture will be taken by a complete stranger. True story that happened to me...

All of these examples are relationship building. Sonship. Having a relationship with Our Father. Dispelling the religious myth that God is not concerned with minut details, or He is only to be accessed for prayer requests... Many of which could be avoided if we had previously A S K E D, then followed Instruction (O B E Y).

You don't see animals always
"Praying About It."
Just ASK.

Because, there are also some places you ought not to go. Even if it does seem good.

I remember asking could I go to a Wedding out of state. I waited and waited for an answer. I heard nothing. Well time was approaching for me to buy airfare at a reasonable price. I needed an answer.

So spiritually speaking, I was like knock, knock, knock, Hello. I Asked. Can I go?

Knock and it [the door] shall be opened. **Matthew 7:7**

The audible response I received from the Spiritual Realm was, “Why would you want to go to something I did not ordain?”

I stayed home.

If the Lord is your Daily Bread, then Daily A S K Him for ALL things.

But this thing commanded I them, saying, Obey my voice, and I will be your God, and ye shall be my people: and walk ye in all the ways that I have

commanded you, that it may be well unto you. **Jeremiah 7:23**

Because he will send his angels with a loud trumpet call, and they will gather his elect from the four winds, from one end of the heavens to the other.

Matthew 24:31

**If your ears are not in tune to the
Spiritual Realm of God, how will you
hear that call?**

Isaiah 55:3

Incline your ear, and come unto me: hear, and your soul shall live; and I will make an everlasting covenant with you, *even* the sure mercies of David.

Proverbs 18:5 The heart of the prudent getteth knowledge; and the ear of the wise seeketh knowledge.

Matthew 7:24 Therefore whosoever heareth these sayings of mine, and doeth them, I will liken him unto a wise man, which built his house upon a rock:

Romans 2:13

For it is not the hearers of the Law who are just before God, but the doers of the Law will be justified

James 1:22-24

But prove yourselves doers of the word, and not merely hearers who delude themselves. For if anyone is a hearer of the word and not a doer, he is like a man who looks at his natural face in a mirror; for once he has looked at himself and gone away, he has immediately forgotten what kind of person he was. “Yeah I know the Bible says I am supposed to do A, B, C. Be a doer of the Word you Hear.
