Subject: What Next?

---

If you've recently accepted Christ and became a Believer in and on the name of Jesus, you may be wondering what to do next.

### Step One.

Hopefully you received a Bible. While the King James Version is universal, it can be a bit daunting. I recommend a parallel Bible containing the King James Version, as well as the English Standard Version, including a concordance. The reason varied translations of the Bible are not recommended is because Truth is lost when one or more words are omitted, or exchanged. For instance. **"The"** Way is quite different from **"A"** Way.

God says I AM THAT I AM. **Exodus 3:14**

Jesus says **I am...**

**John 6:48, 51, John 10:7-9, 14, John 11:25, John 14:6**

I would also recommend a journal, or notepad to ask questions or make comparisons while reading your Bible.

### Step Two.

Begin reading your Bible at the book of John and the book of Genesis. The book of John explains Jesus coming to earth. The book of Genesis depicts the cause of him being sent to earth.

The Bible is a roadmap.

## Step Three.

Turn away from the sinful places, and habits you once embodied by establishing friendships with those who don't more merely go to church, but are actually living Christ centered lifestyles. They are not on Christian dating websites, or, saying "I know I'm not supposed to.. but..the Lord knows my heart"

Ask the Lord for help in areas where you may be weak. For there is no temptation to man [that he is unaware] and have provided a route of escape: If you used to drink, fornicate, go to clubs, or dress provocatively. You cannot serve two masters.

***When you change, what you once attracted, or were attracted to will also change.***

***Others should outwardly see the change in you!***

Filter your eye and ear gates. Not all "gospel" music is Christian, and not every movie or book is acceptable unto God. When in doubt, ask would you want Jesus to watch or listen with you? The goal is to no longer feed your flesh.

## Step Four.

Make sure wherever you gather on a regular basis, you are being taught the entire Bible, Old and New Testament, as it is written with correct understanding, and interpretation by the Holy Spirit; Not man's opinions.

For instance I heard a Pastor on the radio tell his congregation they did not possess the authority or power to do what Jesus and his Disciples did while on earth. That right was reserved only for them taken from Matthew 10:1

This is false doctrine. It is clearly written:

- ... **if you continue in my word you are my disciples indeed. John 8:31.**
- **He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do. John 14:12**

- **And these things shall follow them that Believe; in my name shall they cast out devils, they shall speak with many new tongues; They shall take up serpents (figuratively) and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them, they shall lay hands on the sick and they shall recover. Mark 16:17-18**
- **Behold I give unto you power to tread upon serpents and scorpions and over all the power of the enemy; and nothing shall by any means hurt you. Luke 10:19**

Furthermore, the earth is now as it was then. Therefore Disciples of Christ, We got work to do!
